

Annie Lucille Stevens (1876- 1941)

Annie Stevens never married. Except for a period of college attendance, she lived with her brother throughout their entire lives. When her mother, Mary Stevens, died in 1916, virtually the entire family estate was left to Annie. In 1923 Annie became the donor of the first 40 acres of the Stevens Memorial Park (named in honor of her parents); in 1926 she became the founder of the Stevens Park Estates residential subdivision. She subsequently developed other family farmlands into the Stevens Park Shopping Center and the Stevens Park Village subdivision.
