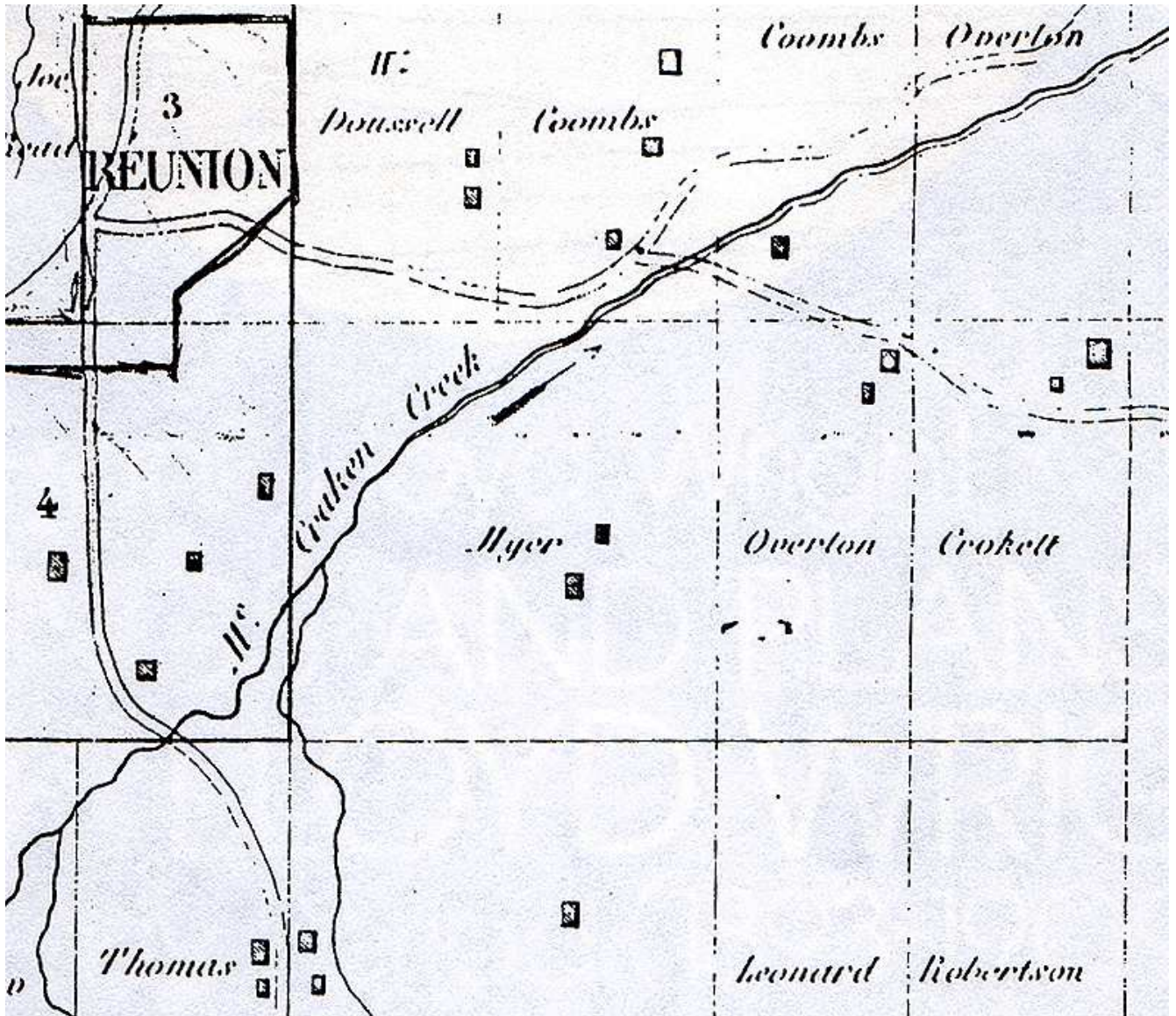


1855 cabins in the “Williams Myers Section”:

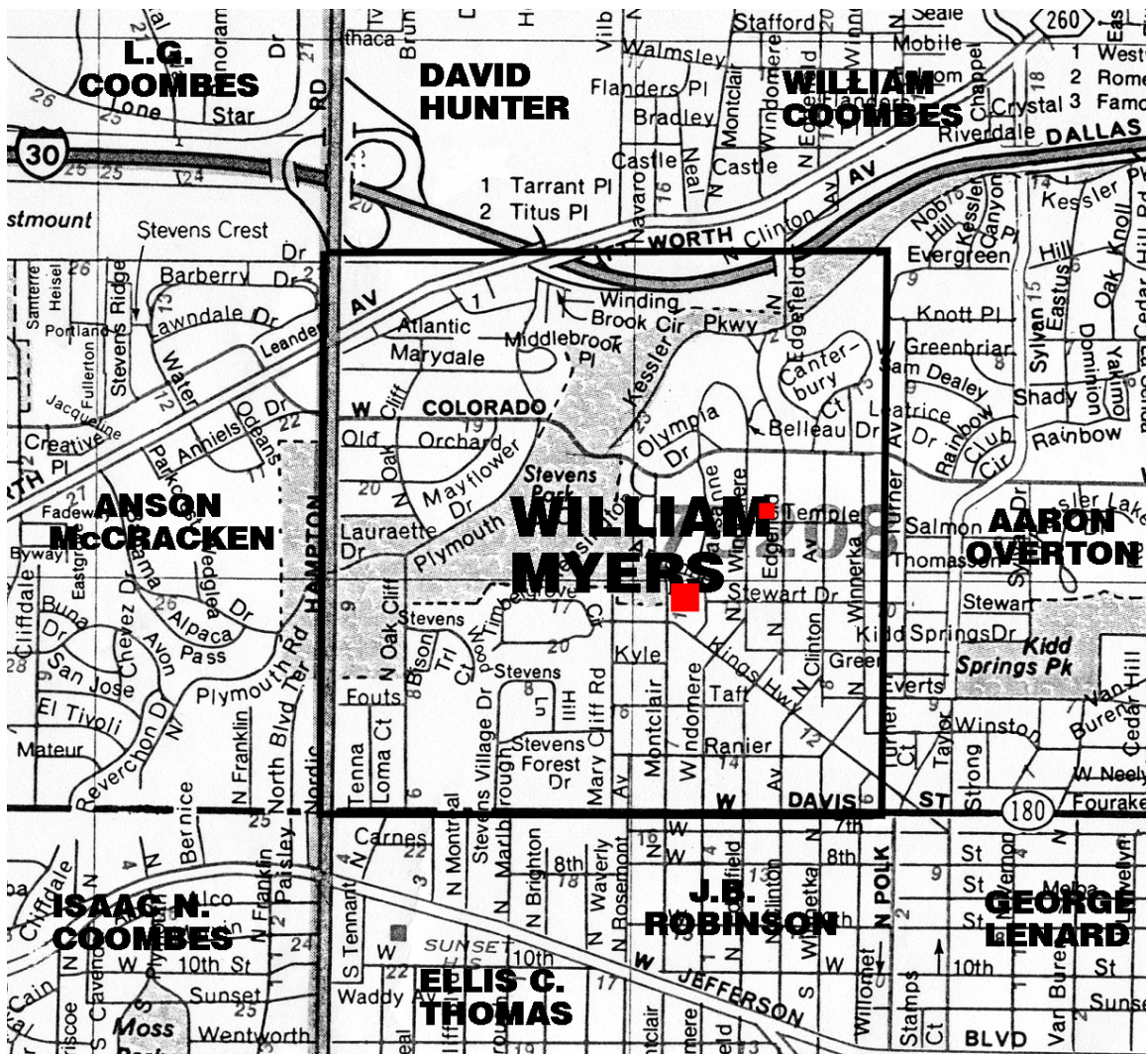


Two cabins inside the *William Myers Section* are illustrated on this detail of a map of western Dallas County drawn by La Reunion colonists, dated 1855.

On a modern map, the first cabin’s position measures as being just west of the end of Stewart Drive, on the crest between Lausanne and Montclair, just south of Argonne.

A second cabin is between Edgefield and Windomere, just south of Temple.





We have no way of telling whether the 1855 map was highly accurate or not, or whether the first cabin being drawn larger held any special significance.

William and Mary Myers owned both cabin sites in 1855; they occupied at least one of them. Occupancy of the second is unknown, probably one of their children's households.
