

244. ROSEMONT, 1910
Rosemont, the residence of Roman S. Waldron, was one of the first homes built in the Winnetka Heights section of Oak Cliff. Waldron, an independent real estate broker, constructed the home c. 1906 at the southwest corner of Rosemont and Davis streets. It was razed in 1957 to build an apartment complex.
